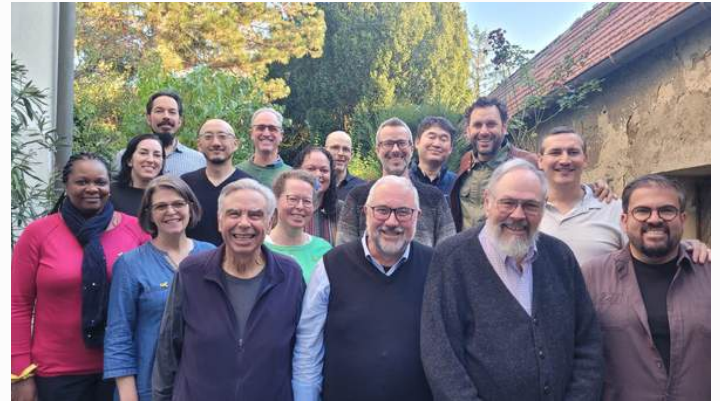

DIPLOMATIC COURSE



From 28 November to 1 November, the so-called TJCII Diplomatic Course took place in Hainburg, Austria with 14 participants from Israel, Europe, the United States, South America and Asia. The course was conducted by 3 members of the ILC Executive Committee: Brain Cox, Dan Juster and Johannes Fichtenbauer. The course was very intensive and included discussions, workshops and group work.

The aim of the course was not only to gain a deeper understanding of the vision of TJCII, or knowledge about how to reach out to representatives of different churches with this vision but above all to pass on the experience of a shared journey within TJCII ILC, which requires humility, a spirit of repentance and openness.

The facilitators hope that the time spent together will allow participants to build bonds that will allow them to prophetically represent the vision of the One New Man.

GENERAL INTERCESSIONS

We pray for the **ILC** as they pray and make plans for the Jerusalem summit. May the hand of the LORD be upon them and the Ruach Ha Kodesh guide them in all things.

We pray for the young leaders who attended **training as ambassadors of TJCII** in Hainburg at the end of Oct. May the LORD empower them in all that He has in store for them, leading them on His paths and empowering them with His Ruach Ha Kodesh.

We pray for the ongoing **war with Israel**. LORD we seek you - your help, your wisdom, your protection, your healing. May your own purposes for Israel be fulfilled and may the world see you glorified in the midst of your people.

We pray for all the **remaining hostages in Gaza**. LORD, may your own Holy presence be with each of them, bringing comfort and blessing. Two guests who initially agreed have resigned due to important personal reasons. We are waiting for another guest to respond to the invitation. The guest from the Gentile side will be Johannes Fichtenbauer.

Let us pray for the messianic guest. And for the protection of all preparations, participants and speakers. May this be a time to enter more deeply into the mystery of the One New Man.

Switzerland

In preparation for the DACH weekend at the end of January 2025, Hans Scholz, Christoph Monsch and Markus Neurohr met with Jonathan Richter. A few days later, we met with other registered participants via Zoom and were blessed by a deep and personal exchange.

On Tuesday, October 29, the German-Swiss TJCII team met in Zurich to gratefully review the past and plan the next steps. We always break bread and have a time of worship.

We look forward to November 9, 2024, when the 'Kingdom of God among us' group will meet in Zurich, including with Greek Orthodox brothers and sisters who long for unity with other Christians and are interested in TJCII.

We pray for the study day on November 21-22 in Spital am Phyrn, Austria, to which Johannes Fichtenbauer has invited. A small group of people who have been dealing with the question "substitution confession/repentance" for a long time want to find a common line for TJCII on the topic. We bless them all and Martin Rösch, who will be there for us.

2025 - 1700 years of the Council of Nicaea: Martin Hoegger has researched the history of the separation from our Jewish brothers and sisters after this council. Instead of the newsletter, we have published a new edition of the TJCII Basics.

- We pray for a benevolent reception and sharing of these documents.
- We ask God for the spirit of repentance in all churches for the separation from our Jewish brothers and sisters
- We ask for courageous signs in our churches, for example on January 17, the Day of Judaism or another date.

Various doors are opening for the vision of a Day of Judaism on January 17 that includes Messianic Jews. Messianic Jews are like a bridge or a hinge between Jews and Gentiles, but also among us Christians. January 17 also connects the two weeks of prayer, the Alliance Week of Prayer and that for Christian Unity. Helpful documents on this from Rita and Hans Scholz, 'Praying with Esther for and with Israel' and other suitable texts for prayers for Israel can be found on our website.

We pray for Israel Works Switzerland IWS – which has been maintaining a network of solidarity with Israel for years. They are a point of contact for the Israeli Embassy and Jewish associations, and support important individual initiatives.

France
